

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCOA BEACH, FLORIDA, SITTING AS AN ELECTION CANVASSING BOARD TO CERTIFY THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010:

- FOR CANDIDATE SEAT NO. 5,
- CONFIRMING THAT THE CANDIDATE FOR SEAT NO. 4, WAS UNOPPOSED AND RE-ELECTED, AND
- FOR THE REFERENDUM DEALING WITH THE LENGTH OF COMMISSION TERM OF OFFICE.

WHEREAS, as of the Registration Book Closing for the November 2, 2010, General Election, there was a total of 8,865 Registered Voters in Cocoa Beach; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Skip Williams, Seat 4, whose Commission term would have expired on November 2010, was unopposed and re-elected for a four (4) year term.

WHEREAS, the November 2, 2010, a General Election was held to elect a City Commissioner for Seat 5; and

WHEREAS, three candidates, Don John (incumbent,) Mary Nail, and Dave Netterstrom qualified to run for City Commissioner Seat 5; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2010, out of 5,007 votes cast, Don John received 1,601 votes, Mary Nail received 838 votes, and Dave Netterstrom received 2,568 votes; and

WHEREAS, the November 2, 2010, a General Election was also held to vote on the following referendum:

“AMENDING THE CHARTER TO HOLD EVEN-YEAR ELECTIONS OF COMMISSIONERS EXCEPT FOR PETITIONS AND COMMISSION VACANCIES

“Shall Cocoa Beach amend its charter to hold even-year elections for Mayor and Commissioners while allowing voting on Commission vacancies or petitions in odd-numbered years; increasing the Commissioners’ and Mayor’s terms from 3 years to 4 years, staggered as follows; Mayor Seat 1 expires in 2012 - instead of 2011, Seat 2 expires in 2012- no change, Seat 3 expires in 2012- no change, Seat 4 expires in 2010 and Seat 5 expires in 2010?”

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2010, out of 5,095 votes cast, 2,680 votes were received in favor of the referendum, and 2,415 votes were received against the referendum; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that with the approval of this Resolution, we do hereby declare that:

- the referendum was adopted


