

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016 - 10**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCOA BEACH, FLORIDA,

- ADOPTING A MASTER RESOLUTION FOR PARKING RATES, WHICH:
  - COMBINES RECENTLY-ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS IN REFERENCE TO PAID PARKING
  - ADDS A NEW METERED PARKING ZONE – THE SOUTH ORLANDO METERED PARKING ZONE,
  - ADOPTS PARKING RATES AT METERED PARKING SPACES, PARKING AT PARKS, AND RATES CHARGED FOR PARKING PERMITS;
  - ADOPTS PARKING METERED AREAS AND PARKING PERMIT VALUE AS EXHIBITS, AND FOLLOWS:
    - EXHIBIT 1 - SOUTH ORLANDO METERED PARKING ZONE**

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60           **WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Cocoa Beach adopted Ordinance No. 1520 on  
61 September 16, 2010, amending City Code Section 26-23 authorizing the cost of parking or standing a  
62 vehicle in a marked parking space located in a parking zone to be established by resolution; and,  
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64           **WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to adopt parking fees for a new parking meter zone, to  
65 be known as the South Orlando Metered Parking zone; and  
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67           **WHEREAS**, the City Commission last adopted parking fees as follows for:

- 68           - the City Hall Paid Metered Parking zone by Resolution No. 2015-12,
- 69           - the Downtown Street Parking meter zone by Resolution No. 2011-39,
- 70           - the 22 North Atlantic Avenue parking lot by Resolution No. 2011-33,
- 71           - Shepard and Sidney Fischer Park by Resolution No. 2015-14,
- 72           - parking meters by Resolution No. 2010-19, and
- 73           - parking permits by Resolution No. 2011-31.

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75           **WHEREAS**, on February 19, 2015, the City Commission adopted Resolution 2015-02, adopting a  
76 Downtown Parking Master Plan; and  
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78           **WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to adopt this Resolution, as a comprehensive  
79 Resolution, to reflect the parking zones, City Parks parking fees, metered-parking fees, rules associated  
80 with parking at metered zones, and adopting fees for parking permits.  
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82           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Cocoa Beach,  
83 Florida, as follows:  
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85           **SECTION ONE: INCORPORATION OF RECITALS** - The above recitals are true and correct  
86 and by reference are hereby incorporated and made an integral part hereof as though fully set forth  
87 herein.  
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**SECTION TWO: REFERENCE TO EXHIBITS** This Resolution hereby refers to paid parking zones, metered parking areas, and parking permit fees as exhibits and in the following manner:

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**SECTION THREE: ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING AND PARKING PERMIT RATES** - There are hereby established rates for the paid parking zones as follows:

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**EXHIBIT 1 - SOUTH ORLANDO METERED PARKING ZONE (Parking Lot)**

**Fees**

The following schedule of parking fees for the South Orlando Metered Parking Zone is hereby established:

<b><u>Per Hour/Day</u></b>	<u>For all days two dollars (\$2.00) per hour or ten dollars (\$10.00) per day. For the purposes of implementing a day begins at 12:00 AM and ends at 11:59 PM. Daily rate payments made on one day are valid only for the day on which that payment was made.</u>
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
<b><u>Special Events</u></b>	<u>Fees for special events or for special purposes, including the waiving of any fee or rate, may be set by the City Manager after due notice to the City Commission. In no case shall the parking fees for special events or special purposes be for periods of more than ten (10) days for any one (1) event or purpose.</u>
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<b><u>Service Fees</u></b>	<u>In addition to parking fees identified above, there may be assessed additional service fees for pay by cell, debit/credit/smart cards or other parking service or payment fees, established and levied directly by the payment service provider through contract and/or agreement with the City. Daily rate payments made on one day are valid only for the day on which that payment was made.
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

**EXHIBIT 3 - DOWNTOWN STREETS PARKING METER ZONE (Metered Parking)**

**Fees**

The following schedule of parking fees for the Downtown Street Parking Meter Zone is hereby established:

<b>Per Hour</b>	For the period February 1 <sup>st</sup> through September 30 <sup>th</sup> for <u>all</u> days; <del>Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays</del> from 8AM to 5:00PM, the parking fee shall be <del>\$2.50 (two dollars and fifty cents)</del> <u>two dollars (\$2.00)</u> per hour.
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<b>Special Events</b>	Fees for special events or for special purposes, including the waiving of any fee or rate, may be set by the City Manager after due notice to the City Commission. In no case shall the parking fees for special events or special purposes be for periods of more than 10 days for any one event or purpose.
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<b>Service Fees</b>	In addition to parking fees identified above, there may be assessed additional service fees for pay by cell, <u>debit/credit/smart cards</u> , or other parking service or payment fees, established and levied directly by the payment service provider through contract and/or agreement with the City. <u>These fees are the responsibility of the end user.</u>
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<b>Parking Permit</b>	Permit Holders are not required to pay the parking fees established or authorized by this Resolution, if they properly possess a valid parking permit.

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
**Exhibit 3A – Downtown Streets Parking Meter Zone (1of 1)**

Any and all marked parking spaces, within the following identified street rights of way and/or alley rights of way and/or public easements:

1. Atlantic Avenue between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street South and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street North;
2. Orlando Avenue between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street South and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street North;
3. Brevard Avenue between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street South and 1<sup>st</sup> Street North;
4. 1<sup>st</sup> Street South between Brevard Avenue and Atlantic Avenue;
5. Minutemen Causeway between Woodland Avenue and Atlantic Avenue;
6. 1<sup>st</sup> Street North between Woodland Avenue and Atlantic Avenue;
7. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street North between Brevard Avenue and Atlantic Avenue.

Excluded from the area/streets/alleys/easements identified above are the following marked spaces:

<b><u>Per Day</u></b>	<p>(b) For all other periods, days and times not listed in (a) above, the parking fee shall be \$1.00 per hour.</p> <p>(c) <del>Daily fee payments made on one day, are valid only for the day (12:00 am to 11:59 pm) on which that payment was made. Daily fee payments authorize parking later than 5:00 pm, but are valid only for the day on which that payment was made. Hourly rate payments made on one day may extend into the next day.</del></p>

<b><u>Special Events</u></b>	<p>(d) Parking fees above may be temporarily modified by the City Manager for special events or for special purposes by written notice to the City Commission. Permanent changes to the parking fees shall be by Resolution of the City Commission. In no case shall the parking fees for special events or special purposes be for periods of more than ten (10) days for any one (1) event or purpose.</p>

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**EXHIBIT 5 – PARKING AT SHEPARD AND FISCHER PARKS (Parking Lots)**

**Fees**

The following schedule of parking fees for Shepard and Fischer Parks is hereby established:

**Per Day**      PARKING FEES. The following schedule of fees shall be adopted:  
 a. The parking fees for Shepard Park shall be fifteen dollars (\$ 15.00) per day, or for any part of a day.  
 b. The parking fees for Sidney Fischer Park shall be fifteen dollars (\$ 15.00) per day or any part of a day.

The fees described above apply only for the day in which the fee is paid. A day is defined as any time interval in which the respective park is open. Vehicles remaining after the park is closed are subject to a Class I citation described in Chapter 31 of the City Code.

**Special Events**      Fees for special events or for special purposes, including the waiving of any fee or rate, may be set by the City Manager after due notice to the City Commission. In no case shall the parking fees for special events or special purposes be for periods of more than ten (10) days for any one (1) event or purpose.

**Service Fees**      In addition to parking fees identified above, there may be assessed additional service fees for pay by cell, or other parking service or payment fees, established and levied directly by the payment service provider through contract and/or agreement with the City.

**Parking Permit**      Parking Permits are not valid in Shepard and Fischer Parks



**Handicap Parking**      The City does not charge a fee for parking on the public streets or highways or in any metered parking spaces if the vehicle displays any of the following disabled parking permits or disabled license plates:

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
**Exhibit 5A – Parking at Shepard – 200 E Cocoa Beach Causeway

**EXHIBIT 6 – PARKING METER ZONE ON CITY STREETS (1 of 1) (Metered Parking)**

<b>Fees</b>	
The following schedule of parking fees for the Parking Meter Zone is hereby established:	
<b><u>Per Hour</u></b>	The cost of parking or standing a vehicle in a parking meter space located in the parking zone shall be changed from one dollar (\$1.00) per hour to one dollar fifty cents (\$1.50) <del>two dollars (\$2.00)</del> per hour; <del>except for the zone including First Street South to Fifteen Street South which will be changed from one dollar (\$1.00) to two dollars (\$2.00).</del> The only coins which the meters accept are those of the United States; The parking meters shall be operated in the parking meter zones twenty-four (24) hours every day, including Sundays and holidays.
<b><u>Special Events</u></b>	Fees for special events or for special purposes, including the waiving of any fee or rate, may be set by the City Manager after due notice to the City Commission. In no case shall the parking fees for special events or special purposes be for periods of more than ten (10) days for any one (1) event or purpose.
<b><u>Service Fees</u></b>	In addition to parking fees identified above, there may be assessed additional service fees for pay by cell, <u>debit/credit/smart cards</u> or other parking service or payment fees, established and levied directly by the payment service provider through contract and/or agreement with the City. <u>These fees are the responsibility of the end user.</u>
<b><u>Parking Permits</u></b>	Permit Holders are not required to pay the parking fees established or authorized by this resolution if they properly possess a valid parking permit.
<b><u>Handicap Parking</u></b>	<p>The City does not charge a fee for parking on the public streets or highways or in any metered parking spaces if the vehicle displays any of the following disabled parking permits or disabled license plates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Disabled parking permits or disabled license plates:</li> <li>✓ out of state or out of country disabled license plate or disabled parking permit as recognized under s. 316.1958, F.S.;</li> <li>✓ disabled parking permit issued under s. 320.0848, F.S.;</li> <li>✓ Disabled Veteran license plate issued under s. 320.084, F.S.;</li> <li>✓ Disabled Veteran license plate stamped with the international wheelchair symbol issued under s. 320.0842, F.S.;</li> <li>✓ license plate stamped with the international wheelchair user symbol issued under s. 320.0843, F.S.; or</li> <li>✓ Paralyzed Veterans of America license plate issued under s. 320.0845, F.S.</li> <li>✓ Specialized equipment, lifts, such as ramps, hand controls for use by a person who has a disability s.316.1964 F.S.</li> <li>✓ Displays a Florida toll Exemption permit. s. 316.1964 F.S.</li> </ul> <p>This only applies when the vehicle is transporting the person who has the disability and to whom the disabled parking permit or license plate was issued.</p> <p>When an on-street parking meter restricts the duration of time that a vehicle may be parked, a vehicle properly displaying a disabled parking permit is allowed a maximum of four hours at no charge.</p> <p>The driver of a vehicle, as provided above, that is parked on the public streets or highways or in any metered parking space may not be penalized except in clearly defined:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ bus loading zones;</li> <li>✓ fire zones;</li> <li>✓ access aisles adjacent to the parking spaces for persons who have disabilities;</li> <li>✓ areas posted as “No Parking” zones or as emergency vehicle zones; or</li> <li>✓ for parking in excess of the posted time limit.</li> </ul>

**EXHIBIT 7 – PARKING PERMITS**

**Fees**

The following parking permit fees are established:

<p><b><u>Annual Value</u></b></p>	<p>The vehicle parking permit shall have an annual value of \$60.00. The vehicle parking permit shall be available for purchase at City Hall during business hours by any person irrespective of place of residence. Proper display of the permit, in decal form, constitutes authorization to park in certain marked timed parking zone without complying with section 26-22 (deposit of coin or other form of payment required), section 26-23 (cost; acceptable coins or other form of payment) and section 26-24 (1) and (2) herein.</p>
<p><b><u>Residents Annual Value</u></b></p>	<p>Residents within the incorporated municipal boundaries of the City of Cocoa Beach shall be able to purchase an annual parking permit decal for \$10 per vehicle with the balance of the \$60 parking permit value to occur through an inter-fund transfer of ad valorem tax receipts to the Metered Parking Fund. On an annual basis, beach maintenance expenditures incurred in the General Fund in a total corresponding amount shall be transferred to the Metered Parking Fund.</p>
<p><b><u>Parking Permit Assignment and Display</u></b></p>	<p>Parking permits are assigned to a single vehicle, are not transferable except on sale, and require proper display by permanently affixing such permit to the driver-side rear bumper or driver-side lower corner of the outside rear window of the vehicle.</p>
<p><b><u>Parking Permit Usage</u></b></p>	<p>Permits shall not be used for parking vehicles for the advertising or other commercial purpose; the city manager or his/her designee shall have the sole discretion to make this determination. The city manager, at his/her sole discretion, retains the authority to rescind any parking permit deemed to be improperly used.</p> <p>Permits are limited to vehicles not to exceed 22 feet in length. <u>It is the responsibility of the vehicle owner to determine vehicle length.</u> Permits shall not be used for overnight parking without the prior approval of the city manager or his/her designee.</p>

**SECTION FOUR: CONFLICTS** - The fees established in this Resolution are solely for the noted exhibits, and parking fees established in other areas of the City are not affected by the adoption of this Resolution.

**SECTION FIVE: VIOLATION AND ENFORCEMENT,**

- (a) Failure to comply with this Resolution, and/or terms and requirements of City Code Chapter 26 "Traffic", Article II "Parking Meters/Parking Devices or Timed Parking System" for parking in the South Orlando Paid Parking Zone shall be subject to a fine, with fines identified in Resolution 2015-13 or successor Resolution.
- (b) This Resolution, and/or terms and requirements of City Code Chapter 26 "Traffic", Article II "Parking Meters/Parking Devices or Timed Parking System" shall be enforced by City parking enforcement specialists, or by City police officers.

**SECTION SIX: POSTING OF THE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES,** The fee schedule identified in **Section Four** above shall be posted on the City website.


