

### Q6 How much time do you typically spend in Downtown Cocoa Beach during each visit?



### Q7 Do you purchase an annual parking pass from the City?



### Q8 How do you typically travel to Downtown Cocoa Beach?



**Q9 What factors are most important to you when deciding where to park? Please rank the following from 1 to 4, with 1 being most important and 4 being least important.**




