RESCINDING ORDERS

1, 2, 3, 6, 10, 12, 12A, 12B and 16,

Effective 11:59 PM, 5/31/20

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Cocoa Beach City Manager by the City Commission of the City of Cocoa Beach, in accordance with Amendment #1, City of Cocoa Beach, Florida, Declaration of Emergency Proclamation, approved March 19, 2020, (“Declaration”), I hereby rescind:

Order 1 (No Alcohol on the Ocean Beach),

Order 2 (Towing and Fines for Parking in Closed Areas),

Order 3 (General Employees Pension Board Emergency Powers of Chair),

Order 6 (Prohibiting Use of Non-Residentially Zoned Property for Beach Parking and Limiting Use of Residentially Zoned Property as to Parking),

Order 10 (Waiving Purchasing Procedures During Emergency to Maintain Towing Continuity),

Order 12 (Restrictions on Activities at the Ocean Beach),

Order 12A (Revised Restrictions on Activities at the Ocean Beach), and

Order 12B (Revised Restrictions on Activities at the Ocean Beach and Revised Beach Parking),

Order 16 (Phase 1 Opening of Restaurants, but Order 16A on the same subject is not rescinded),
