

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-06 (AMENDED)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCOA BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2023-05, A MASTER RESOLUTION FOR FEES, TO:

- CHANGE FEES IN EXHIBIT 9 –UTILITY RATES, REUSE CHARGES; AND
- ADD EXHIBIT 9.5 - FATS, OILS AND GREASE CONTROL FINES AND ENFORCEMENT FEES

PROVIDING FOR:

- AMENDMENT OF FEES
- INCORPORATION OF RECITALS, AND
- PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Cocoa Beach has authorized the adoption of fees by Resolution; and,

WHEREAS Resolution 2023-06 amends Resolution No. 2023-05, amends Exhibit 9, Utility Rates and Reuse Charges and adds a new Exhibit 9.5 entitled Fats, Oils and Grease Control Fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Cocoa Beach, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1: INCORPORATION OF RECITALS - The above recitals are true and correct and by reference are hereby incorporated and made an integral part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 3: AMENDED FEES. The rates in Exhibit 9 - Utility Rates, Reuse Charges are hereby amended, as reflected in the Exhibit. Exhibit 9.5 has been added to reflect Fats, Oils and Grease Control Fines and Enforcement Fees.

SECTION 4: CONFLICTS. The fees established in this Resolution supersede the fees set by prior fees Resolutions.

SECTION 5: POSTING OF THE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES. The Exhibits identified in Section 2 above shall be posted on the City website.

SECTION 6: DIRECTING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ESTABLISHED FEES. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized and directed to implement this Resolution.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall have an effective date of June 1, 2023.
